Note that you have the right to bring a complaint before the Privacy Commissioner concerning any aspect of our processing of your request. Notice of complaint should be addressed to:



Mischief, Intimidation, Unlawful Assembly and Disguise with intent. On 2010-02-13 several hundred protestors marched through the streets of Vancouver protesting the Olympic Games and protestors broke three windows at the Hudson's Bay Company, an official Olympic sponsor. CHA BEAULIEU organized and lead the protest while wearing a disguise and was party to the offence of mischief while participating in an unlawful assembly. Protestors blocked the roadways of Vancouver and vehicle traffic through the protest and by blocking the roadway with newspaper boxes thrown into the street to obstruct traffic. Crowd Control Units deployed by Vancouver Police and the RCMP were required to intervene to disrupt the unlawful assembly. On 2010-02-15 BEAULIEU was arrested for Mischief and Intimidation, provided with his Charter of Rights and transported to Vancouver Police city cells where he was lodged pending a morning court appearance.

Joint Intelligence Group investigators are requesting that BEAULIEU be placed on several conditions prior to his release.

Mischief, Intimidation by blocking a highway, Unlawful Assembly and Disguise with Intent. On 2010-02-13 CHA BEAULIEU directed and organized a group of several hundred protestors who marched through streets of Vancouver protesting the Olympic Games. Prior to starting the march, BEAULIEU made statements overheard by plain clothes police in the area. BEAULIEU stated "when you come across a corporate sponsors...like...RBC...The Bay...feel free to vandalize". BEAULIEU participated in the protests while wearing a disguise, handkerchief and hooded jacket while being party to the offence of Mischief and participating in an unlawful assembly while blocking the roadways in Vancouver. During the protest, protestors damaged property, spray painted objects and broke three windows of the Hudson's Bay Company, an official Olympic sponsor. The assessed value of damage to the Hudson's Bay Company is \$18,600. Crowd Control Units from Vancouver Police and the RCMP were deployed to disrupt the unlawful assembly. On 2010-02-15 BEAULIEU was arrested for Mischief and Intimidation, provided with his Charter of Rights and transported to Vancouver Police cells where he was lodged pending a morning court appearance.

On 2010-02-16, BEAULIEU was released from custody by the courts on an Undertaking to a Justice with seventeen conditions (Court File # 2040:212086-1).

BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION:

The Joint Intelligence Group has been gathering information on groups of interest that pose a threat to the safety and security of the Vancouver 2010 Olympic Games. BEAULIEU came to the attention of the Joint Intelligence Group and his actions are summarized in a separate text page, Overview of Investigation.

PROTEST ON 2010-02-12:

On 2010-02-12, the Olympic Winter Game torch was being run through the streets of Vancouver, BC in preparation for the opening of the 2010 Olympic Games later this date. During the torch run, several protestors gathered at Charles Street and Commercial Drive in the city of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia and were protesting the Olympic Games by demonstrating in the streets. In addition to several thousand supporters present to watch the Olympic Torch run, there were approximately twenty protestors observed dressed all in black, wearing masks and hooded jackets.

One well known individual, Guillaume BEAULIEU, was observed by surveillance team members, Cst. Alan PERRY and Cst. NARDI, at the intersection of Charles Street and Commercial Drive, Vancouver. Surveillance team members observed several anti-Olympic banners being carried by the group and observed CHA, BEAULIEU place a black bandanna over his face and speak to several people within the protest group. BEAULIEU was observed to stand in the middle of a group of people and wave his hands in a manner which appeared to be a gesture to move the group in a march. BEAULIEU was observed to march with the other protestors from this location to the intersection of Commercial Drive and Venables Street, Vancouver.

Cst. PERRY observed the group of protestors that BEAULIEU was with place string, barbed wire and three blocks in the middle of the roadway at the corner of Commercial Drive and Venables Street, blocking the entire intersection. This intersection was part of the intended route of the Olympic Torch relay and as a result of the actions of the protestors, the Olympic torch run had to be diverted from this original route to avoid confrontation with the protestors given the blocking of this intersection.

PROTEST ON 2010-02-13:

On 2010-02-13 at approximately 0830 hours, several hundred protestors to the Olympic Games gathered at Thornton Park which is located at Terminal Avenue and Main Street, in the City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia. This event had been advertised as "Heart Attack" and was promoted through flyers throughout Vancouver.

Several uniformed Vancouver Police members were present at the protest and monitored the activities of the group during the protest.

While at Thornton Park, CHA, Guillaume BEAULIEU was observed by the surveillance team and Joint Intelligence Group members. BEAULIEU was observed to dress all in black and place a burgandy coloured handkerchief over his mouth and nose and pull the hood of his jacket over his head.

BEAULIEU was also observed to use a airhorn to address the group of protestors providing instructions to the group on the use of different colored flags to provide the group directions during the planned march. BEAULIEU was overheard by Cst. WORBETS making the following statements:

"everything goes according to plans...traffic will be stopped from crossing bridge";

"when you come across a corporate sponsors...like...RBC...The Bay...feel free to vandalize or whatever..I'm not your mother" which received applause from the group of protestors.

BEAULIEU was then observed to attend to the front of the group of protestors and held a black flag and practice directing the group of protestors marching through the park using the flag as direction for the protestors while within the park. The group of protestors were overheard chanting anti-Olympic messages while marching. There were approximately eighty to one hundred protestors dressed all in black and were observed by Cst. WORBETS to remain together towards the front of the group.

The march departed at approximately 0900 hours from Thornton Park and travelled west down east Hastings Street to Cambie Street, blocking all lanes of traffic.

Once the protest reached the Hudson Bay Company at West Georgia Avenue and Seymour Street (a corporate sponsor of the Olympic Games), three windows

were broken by the group of protestors. The estimated value of the damage is \$6000. There is also an unconfirmed report that another window was broken at the Toronto Dominion bank on West Georgia Avenue (follow up to be conducted).

Protestors blocked roadways and intentionally placed newspaper boxes and other items in front of vehicle traffic travelling down the road blocking traffic.

The protest group continued to march and at the intersection of Pender Street and Cordova Avenue, Vancouver, crowd control units from Vancouver Police and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police attended the area to prevent the march from continuing.

GROUNDS FOR ARREST:

After information was gathered in relation to the activities of the protest and observations of the Vancouver Police, RCMP Special "O" Surveillance team and Vancouver 2010 Joint Intelligence Group, it was determined by Joint Intelligence Group investigators that BEAULIEU was arrestable for Mischief and Intimidation in relation to his actions on 2010-02-13 at the protest.

Together with the information and observations made on 2010-02-12 and other information gathered by the Joint Intelligence Group, BEAULIEU's actions indicate his position as a leader and organizer of these two protests. BEAULIEU's statements made to the group on 2010-02-13 using an airhorn while organizing the protest indicate his ability to incite the crowd and his acceptance and encouragement of protestors destroying property belonging to corporate sponsors of the Olympic Games during the protest.

BEAULIEU was a leader and participant during the protests on 2010-02-12 and 2010-02-13 and used a disguise on both dates. On 2010-02-12, BEAULIEU used a disguise while being party to the offence of mischief and intimidation by blocking a highway.

ARREST OF BEAULIEU:

On 2010-02-15 surveillance team members made observations of BEAULIEU at his residence at [REDACTED], Vancouver and directed Joint Intelligence Group investigators, Cst. Greg SMITH and Cst. Amber SMITH as to the location of BEAULIEU who located BEAULIEU in the 700 block of East

██████████ Vancouver. At approximately 1112 hours, Cst. Greg SMITH placed BEAULIEU under arrest for Mischief over Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000) pursuant to section 430 (3) of the Criminal Code and Blocking a Roadway pursuant to section 423(1)(g) of the Criminal Code. BEAULIEU refused to acknowledge that he understood. At approximately 1115 hours, Cst. Greg SMITH provided BEAULIEU with his Charter of Rights verbatim from a police card which BEAULIEU refused to acknowledge. At approximately 1117 hours, Cst. Greg SMITH provided BEAULIEU with the official police warning verbatim from the police card and BEAULIEU refused to acknowledge.

On 2010-02-15, Cst. GARIEPY attended to the 700 block of East 10th Avenue, Vancouver on request of Sgt. MacDOUGALL to attend to assist Cst. Greg SMITH as a french speaking member. Cst. Greg SMITH advised Cst. GARIEPY that BEAULIEU was under arrest for Mischief and INTimidation and requested that Cst. GARIEPY provide him with his rights in french.

At 1124 hours, Cst. GARIEPY provided BEAULIEU with his Charter of Rights and police caution in french. When asked if he understood, BEAULIEU did not respond.

SEARCH INCIDENTAL TO ARREST:

On 2010-02-15 between 1112 hour and 1115 hours, BEAULIEU was searched incidental to arrest and seized the following items:

1. Spray paint can
2. Two pieces of metal
3. Elastic band
4. Miscellaneous documents referring to "Heart Attach March" on February 13
5. Red Handkerchief.

TRANSPORT OF BEAULIEU:

On 2010-02-15 at approximately 1244 hours, Cst. Greg SMITH turned BEAULIEU over to the custody of Vancouver Police wagon driver, Cst. Ian ROBESON, PC2676, who transported BEAULIEU to Vancouver city cells.

SECONDARY CAUTION OF BEAULIEU:

At 1320 hours, while at Vancouver city cells, Cst. GARIEPY provided BEAULIEU with his secondary police caution in english and french. BEAULIEU stated he understood and stated that he wished to speak to legal aid.

RIGHT TO COUNSEL:

At 1323 hours, BEAULIEU was placed in a telephone room in private and was given the opportunity to contact Legal Aid. At 1345 hours, BEAULIEU finished speaking with Legal Aid.

INTERVIEW OF BEAULIEU:

Cst. GARIEPY attempted to conduct an interview of BEAULIEU however he

RE: Arrests of anti-Olympic protestors.

INFORMATION

On 2010-02-13, Guillaume BEAULIEU [REDACTED] was observed to be an organizer and leader of the 2010 Heart Attack protest. While marching through downtown Vancouver, the protestors obstructed traffic and engaged in property destruction. BEAULIEU used a disguise while being party to the offense of mischief and intimidation by blocking a highway.

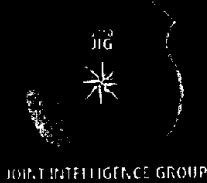

Overview of Investigation:

General Overview:

Guillaume Joseph-Marc BEAULIEU is 27 years old male and was born [REDACTED]

Guillaume BEAULIEU has been an activist for several years and has labeled himself an anarchist and has spoken of himself as Black Bloc. Black Bloc is a term used by individuals involved in protests and marches. People exercising the Black Bloc tactic wear mainly black clothing and put masks over their faces. This is done to appear as one large mass and avoid being identified and to appear as one large mass. Black Blocking is usually connected to some sort of direct action. Tactics of the Black Bloc include vandalism, rioting, street fighting, unlawful assembly, misleading the authorities, assisting in the escape of people arrested during a protest and attacking police. Property destruction carried out by Black Bloc tends to have symbolic significance and their common targets include banks, institutional buildings, outlets for multinational corporations and video surveillance cameras.

Series of Events:

2005-06-22: Guillaume BEAULIEU was involved in a protest in Philadelphia, PA, USA. He was convicted of Resisting Arrest as a result of his actions at this protest and received 6 months in County prison and probation. (RAP sheet attached)

2009-12-17: In December of 2009, Guillaume BEAULIEU went on a speaking tour throughout Quebec and Ontario to motivate people to protest the Olympic Torch Run. On December 17th, 2009, Cpl. Jeff Francis was present in Hamilton, ON while BEAULIEU was speaking at the Skydragon Center. As part of the lecture, BEAULIEU showed the people in the audience how to avoid being handcuffed should they be arrested during a protest.

2010-02-09: An email fan out titled "Anarchist Block in Feb. 12 Demonstration" authored by "Guillaume" calls for "anti-colonial, anti-capitalist and anarchist bloc at the Feb. 12 demo from the Vancouver Art Gallery to BC Place? in struggle against the Olympics" It goes on to say, "For the 12th meet the torch at 9am in Grandview Park, then hook up with the bloc behind the black flags at 3pm at the Art Gallery. Show up for the HeartAttack on the 13th. But don't let it end there, the Olympics are here for a solid two weeks."

2010-02-12: On the morning of February 12th, 2010, Guillaume BEAULIEU led a group of several hundred protesters who were attempting to block the Olympic Torch from its' intended route on Commercial Drive in Vancouver, BC. In doing so the group hauled barricades onto the road and marched in the streets. Traffic had to be re-routed for in excess of an hour with hundreds of people having their lawful use of the road interfered with.

At 3:00 p.m. a group of in excess of 1500 protesters marched from the Vancouver Art Gallery for several blocks to within close proximity of BC PLACE and the opening ceremonies for the Olympic Games. Once at BC PLACE organizers of the protest told the protesters that if they were protesting peacefully they should move behind the torch the group had carried with them but if they were supportive of direct action they should hold the line. There was a group of several dozen "black bloc" in the crowd, all of who stayed at the front line ahead of the torch. Guillaume BEAULIEU was in that group.

2010-02-13: On the morning of February 13th, 2010, Guillaume BEAULIEU departed his residence and attended to Thornton Park in Vancouver, BC. He surrounded himself with people and slid black tear away pants over his jeans, changed his blue jacket for a black one with a hood, which he pulled up and then he covered his face with a red bandana.

A short time later BEAULIEU was in possession of, and started instructing the crowd with a bull horn. He told the protest group how directions would be passed to them using different flags. BEAULIEU then talked about planning to stop traffic on the bridge to Whistler. BEAULIEU finishes the briefing by saying, "when you come across corporate sponsors like BC? The Bay? Feel free to vandalize or whatever? I'm not your mother." BEAULIEU then told the group they will practice with the black flags. BEAULIEU headed to the front of the group with a black flag and practiced a short time before he led the group into the street on Main Street, near Terminal Avenue in Vancouver, BC effectively stopping traffic from traveling down the street in either direction.

The group traveled from Main Street to East Hastings Street, where they turned west and travelled approximately 15 blocks before having a confrontation with police and breaking into smaller groups. BEAULIEU ended up with a group of protesters on Robson Street where the group finally dispersed. The group blocked traffic and had pedestrians in the downtown core of Vancouver running a roller coaster of emotions from fear to rage more than two hours.

During their travels the protest group broke windows at The Hudson's Bay Company and TD Canada Trust, they spray painted and damaged private vehicles, dragged dozens of newspaper boxes into the middle of the street and vandalized them and even pulled a dumpster into the middle of the road and overturned it. Reports of property damage continue to flow into the Vancouver Police Department and insurance companies throughout the lower mainland. The number cannot be estimated at present but is easily in excess of \$5,000.

To avoid detection, BEAULIEU changed back out of his black clothing and into the clothing he was wearing when he arrived at the park in the morning. BEAULIEU went to 459 East Hastings Street where he trimmed his beard into a goatee before reemerging.

2010-02-15: At 11:12 hours Car Greg SMITH arrested Guillaume BEAULIEU for mischief over \$5000 (Sec. 430 CC) and intimidation by blocking a highway (Sec. 423(1)(g) CC) and provided BEAULIEU his RTC and PW. Search incident to arrest located spray paint, and a handkerchief of the same pattern and color BEAULIEU was wearing when he led the protest on February 13th, 2010. Both were on BEAULIEU's person. Car. SMITH also

seized two metal objects similar in appearance to those used to smash the windows at the Hudson's Bay Company on February 13th, 2010.

The number of people whose lawful enjoyment of the city's streets, both driving and walking, and the sheer terror displayed by citizens who were helpless to watch as the mob led by Guillaume BEAULIEU roamed through the streets of Vancouver is vast and will never be known. The amount of damage and the number of victims that are affected by the mischief which occurred during the protest led by Guillaume BEAULIEU on February 13th, 2010 is also significant and continues to grow. The police investigation is continuing and although cumbersome, will be completed in a timely fashion. New victims are still reporting mischief to property. Video and still photography from literally hundreds of sources will need to be analyzed in an attempt to identify the culprits of each individual criminal act and to capture Guillaume BEAULIEU's actions throughout this period.

The Joint Intelligence Group (JIG) respectfully requests that Mr. BEAULIEU be held in custody until the Olympic Games are complete, as this event is clearly the focus of his anger. At the time of his release the JIG would ask Mr. BEAULIEU be placed on conditions stringent enough to ensure the public's need to be protected against such acts is ensured.
